We want to be proud of our drive participating in Nebraska's 150th birthday celebration so we ask that everyone please adhere to the rules of the road, pay close attention to your surroundings, and make this a day to be proud of our event!!! Please also be flexible, as we never know what might change at the last minute. We will be enforcing all the safety rules and reserve the right to pull anyone from the line up if we feel there might be a problem. We want to make a good impression on Lincoln!

If it is raining and the lot in Lincoln is muddy there may be a change of plans regarding shuttling ahead in the morning – we will not know until Thursday or Friday morning whether or not there will be a change in plans.

- 6:00am Shuttle leave to move ahead to 6821 SW 12th Street.
- 6:30-7:30am Breakfast provided & served by Crete FFA Alumni Association and Crete High School FFA. Certified Angus Beef Steaks, scrambled eggs, hash browns. Will be either free will donation or free, TBD. Those at breakfast will need to obtain a wrist band for the drive into Lincoln if they have not done so already.
- 7:45am Tractor Meeting
- 8:00am Leave west out of Tuxedo Park the way we came in the night before traveling to Hwy 33/13th Street. We will most likely have a police escort to get onto Hwy 33. Will travel to stop light at 13thS & Hawthorne Ave and turn left. We will continue on Hwy 33 and turn left at Hwy 103. We will continue on Hwy 103 to Denton Road (9 miles) and take a right on Denton Road. In 4 miles will arrive in Denton and turn right at Lancaster Avenue to W 3rd.
- 10:00am Arrive in Denton for break and mandatory fill up with gas/diesel at the Super C Store.
- 10:45am Leave Denton. Take Denton Road right on 290 to SW 12th, turn left (north) to the grass lot just north of 6821 SW 12th Street.

Anyone that may be joining us for the first time at 6821 SW 12th Street must be UNLOADED AND CHECKED IN BY 11:00 A.M. with Relay Coordinator, Donelle Moormeier. You will need to receive a wrist band to drive your tractor into Lincoln. You may bring your tractor the night before and unload.

Everyone should have a wrist band and these WILL BE CHECKED. You should have a full tank of fuel. If Safety Coordinator, Ron Moormeier, deems a tractor is not running properly for the drive into Lincoln, you will be asked to pull out of the lineup. We will have groups of 20-25 tractors that will be led by someone who knows the route. Absolutely NO HORSEPLAY, NO ALCOHOL, and NO RIDERS IF THEY HAVE NOT BEEN APPROVED BY MAY 1ST DEADLINE. We will need to keep tractors close together and follow traffic lights!

- 1:15pm Leave for Capitol. North on SW 12th Street past Old Cheney turns into Pioneer Blvd. Continue on Pioneers Blvd and turn left on S. Folsom. Turn right on Rosa Parks Way and stay in the right hand lane/shoulder. Rosa Parks Way turns into K Street. Take a right turn at 16th Street, take a

- right turn at H Street, take a right turn at 14th Street. Stop for a minute in front of Capitol at J Street for photographer to take a pictures. (not confirmed yet) There will be police presence.
- 2:00pm Will begin arriving at Capitol. Please keep the tractors close together and follow all the traffic lights or the police presence. Leaving Capitol continue north on 14th Street, you will have 4 blocks to get moved over into the left hand lane. Turn left on N Street. Stay in the middle lane until Canopy Street and then move to right hand lane. Please be courteous to those that are trying to back out of parking stalls etc. Stay in right hand lane at the green sign turn right, you will be on Pinnacle Arena Drive. Follow Pinnacle Arena Drive to N. 8th Street, turn right and enter parking lot at 645 N. 8th (Polygon Parking).
Depending on how many tractors we have registered we will probably all have arrived at the parking lot by 3:30.

- 6:15am Leave to shuttle ahead to Springfield (via Hwy only 45 miles)
- 7:45am Driver meeting
- 8:00am Leave from Southwest 12th proceed south on SW 12th 3 miles, turn left onto Saltillo Road, proceed 1 mile. SW 2nd St turn right, proceed 3 miles at Hwy 33 (Roca Rd) turn left and proceed 8 ½ miles East (driving through Roca) to 120th ST, turn left (north) and proceed 3 miles. At Saltillo Rd turn right and proceed 3 miles. At Bennet Rd turn left, proceed almost 1 miles, turn right into Casey's (21 miles)
- 10:00am Arrive at Casey's General Store for AM break.
- 10:30am Leave for Camp Cree (15 miles) Turn right from Casey's, proceed across Hwy 2 overpass, make a slight right turn onto 162nd, proceed 14 miles (includes east O St/US#34 crossing). At 162nd & Bluff Rd turn right, proceed ¾ mile to Camp Creek Thresher's show grounds.

- 2:00pm Leave for Ashland (12 miles) Turn right on US 6 proceed appr. 1 miles, turn right onto Cottonwood Rd (turns into Mynard) proceed 2 miles+, cross over I-80 overpass, turn left at first Rd south of Shell station, continue on Mynard Rd 2 miles. At 262nd turn left proceed 3 miles, join blacktop Rd Nebr #66 follow to and cross US 6, continue onto and through Ashland on Nebr. #66, continue 1 ½ mile.
- 3:00pm Onto Holy Family Shrine Church (9 miles) turn right at Nebr #66 & County Rd "A" (signage points to Nebraska National Guard Camp). Proceed 2 miles going beyond NGC. Take short RD to US 6, turn left, proceed 1 ½ mile crossing Platte River bridge. Turn right on Pflug Rd, proceed to dead end, turn right proceed to I-80 overpass, turn left and cross I-80, continue to dead end. Turn left on Fishery Rd to Pflug Rd, proceed to church parking lot. **Note: We will have to work around road construction where we enter US 6 off of the road past NGC. Constructors Inc., is redoing two bridges and resurfacing the road between Ashland and the Platte river bridge. There will be one lane traffic and traffic signals to deal with, please watch carefully.**
- 3:45pm Arrive at the Holy Family Shrine Catholic Church. This is an unusual all glass Church that sets on a bluff overlooking the valley.
- 4:30pm Leave for Springfield (21 miles) Follow Rd from parking lot onto Fishery Rd, follows along east and north side of the Platte River. In 6 miles turn right onto Nebr #31, also known as Mopac Trail, proceed 4 miles. At NE 31 & 192nd turn left, proceed 4 miles, at Pflug Rd turn right, proceed 3 miles. Cross Hwy 50, proceed approximately ¼ mile, at 1st St turn left, proceed to Main St and turn left. At corner of Sarpy County Fair Grounds (one block) turn right.
