9:15 – BREAK- WEST ON 91 TO WEST END LOUP ROAD, TAKE A RIGHT-HAND TURN GO APPROX. 1 MILE TO INTERSECTION OF DRY VALLEY ROAD TURN LEFT ONTO DRY VALLEY ROAD, NORTH LOUP RIVER BRIDGE TO YOUR RIGHT. BREAK. WHEN BREAK IS OVER GO APPROX ONE MILE TO HIGHWAY 91 ON DRY VALLEY ROAD. TURN RIGHT.

HALSEY – 48 MILES TODAY - MULLEN

5:00 – SHUTTLE TO MULLEN

7:30 – BREAKFAST AND DRIVERS MEETING BREAKFAST WILL BE SERVED AT THE REC AREA AT 4H CAMP

8:00 – LEAVE HALSEY 4H CAMP GO BACK TO HIGHWAY 2 TURN LEFT TOWARDS THEDFORD

10.00 – BREAK AT THEDFORD. PARK AROUND THE SQUARE TERI LICKING

10:30 – LEAVE THEDFORD FOR SENECA STAY ON HIGHWAY 2 WILL TURN RIGHT OFF OF HIGHWAY 2 AT SENECA TURN OFF. GO 1 MILE NORTH THROUGH THE TOWN OF SENECA CROSS THE BNSF RR TRACKS TO THE DEAD END. TURN RIGHT AND GO EAST TO RED BARN ON RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD.

12:00 – STOP AT STABLE PRODUCTIONS EXOTIC GAME RANCH FOR LUNCH. TAKE
IN ALL THE SIGHTS OF EXOTIC ANIMALS.

TAKE A RIGHT-HAND TURN TO FARMERS RANCHERS COOP. **EVERYONE MUST FUEL UP TODAY!! THERE WILL BE NO TIME OR AVAILABILTY TO FUEL OTHER THAN HERE!! MULLEN – 75 MILES TODAY! - ARTHUR

5:00 MST – SHUTTLE AHEAD TO ARTHUR

7:45 – DRIVERS MEETING

8:00 – LEAVE MULLEN FROM FAIRGROUNDS GO BACK TO HIGHWAY 2 MAKE A LEFT TURN HEADING EAST. AT HIGHWAY 97 MAKE A RIGHT TURN GO SOUTH TOWARD TRYON. WHEN WE GET ACROSS THE DISMALL RIVER WE WILL BE TAKING A BREAK.

MID MORNING BREAK. HALF WAY BETWEEN MULLEN AND TRYON AT THE FARR RANCH. PLEASE STAY ON THE ROAD. **DO NOT DRIVE ON THE GRASS AT THE HEADQUARTERS!!! THIS IS A CIRCLE DRIVE! PLEASE RESPECT THEIR PROPERTY!! THEY ARE GRACIOUSLY LETTING US STOP TO TAKE A BREAK.** LEAVE THE RANCH GET BACK ON THE HIGHWAY AND TURN SOUTH OR RIGHT.

5:00 - SHUTTLE TO OGALLALA

7:00 - BREAKFAST AFTER BREAKFAST THERE ARE PLACES OF INTEREST TO SEE IN ARTHUR. SOME OF THE HISTORICAL SITES ARE THE BUNK HOUSE BAR AND GRILL, WOLF DEN MARKET, ROSE SADDLERY, MARSHALL'S HAT SHOP, AND MAY'S PLACE. PLEASE FEEL FREE TO GO AND EXPLORE A GREAT PART OF HISTORY.

10:00 – LEAVE ARTHUR FOR OGALLALA PLEASE BE AWARE! THERE WILL BE ROAD CONSTRUCTION ON HIGHWAY 61 GOING TO OGALLALA. THE PEOPLE WORKING ON THE ROAD HAVE BEEN INFORMED THAT WE WILL BE COMING THRU.
